It enables Lifesize Icon room systems to be used in hardware-based and software-based configurations with Windows and Mac computers to join meetings hosted on any collaboration app or service.



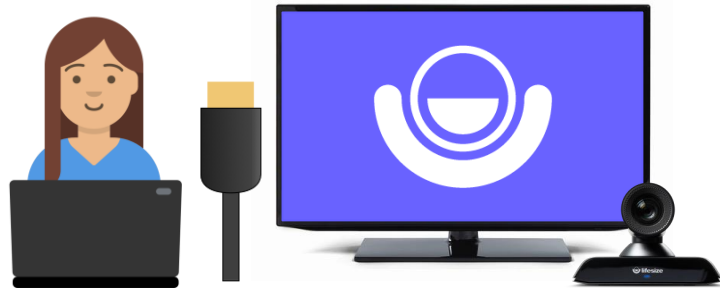

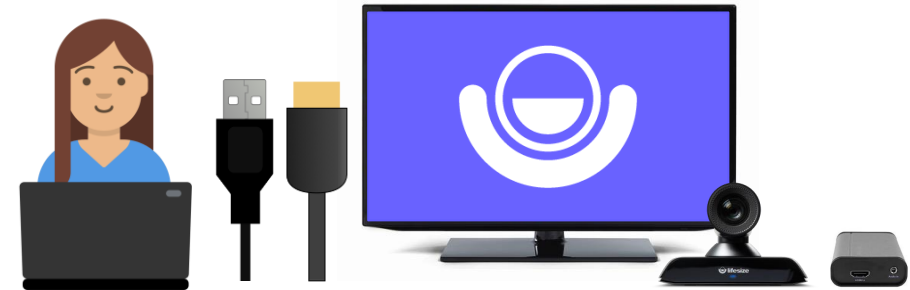


Lifesize Connect Configuration Overview



Software-Based Configuration

- Supported by Lifesize Icon 700, Icon 500 & Icon 300
- Single-display configuration
- Requires HDMI cable
- Requires user to download & install a lightweight application on their Windows or Mac computer



Hardware-Based Configuration

- Supported by Lifesize Icon 700 & Icon 500
- Single-display & dual-display configurations
- Requires USB cable and HDMI cables
- Requires third-party hardware peripheral(s):
 - HDMI-to-USB C capture device
 - HDMI splitter/scaler (dual-display configuration)

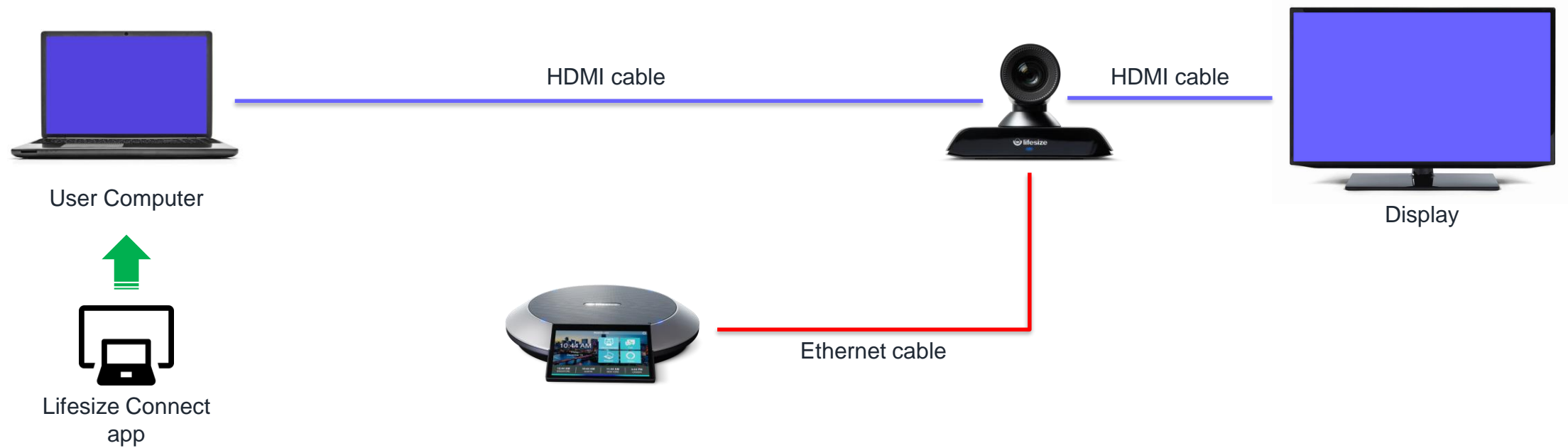

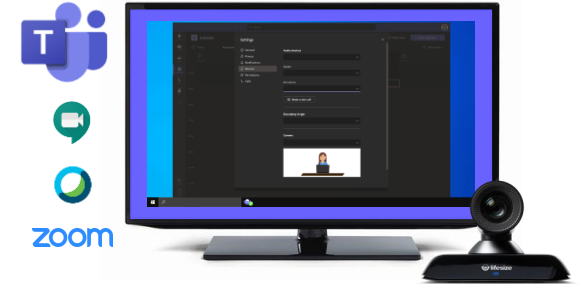

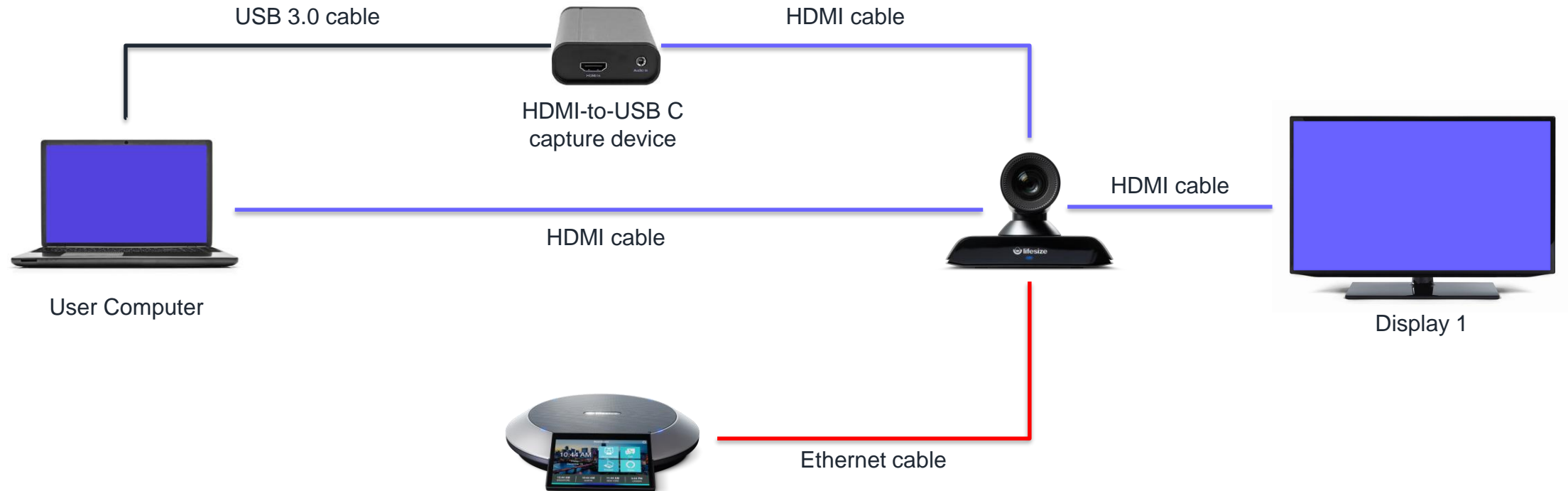

Hardware-Based Deployment: Single Display

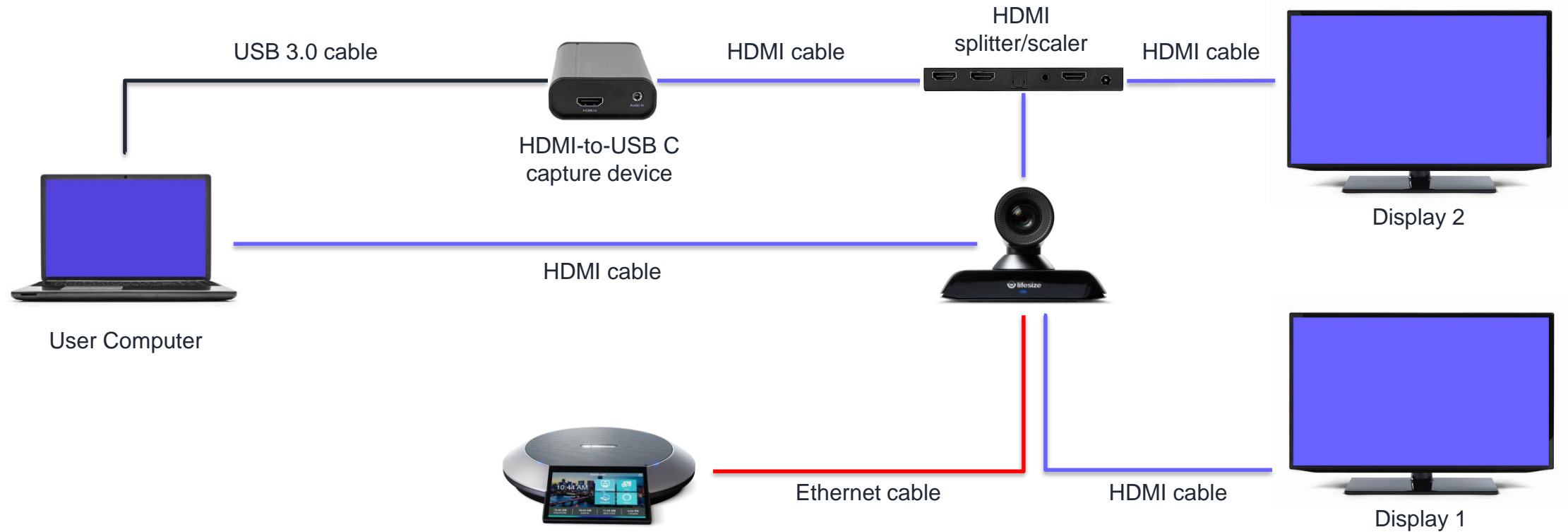

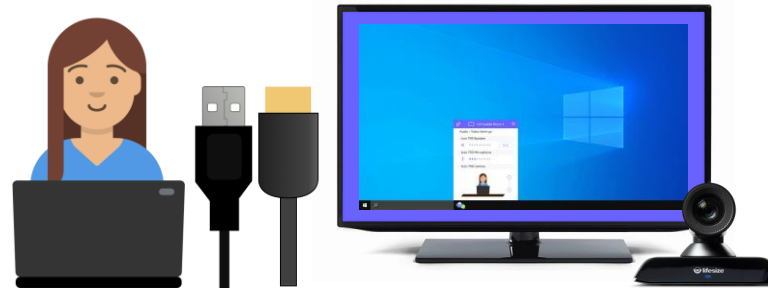

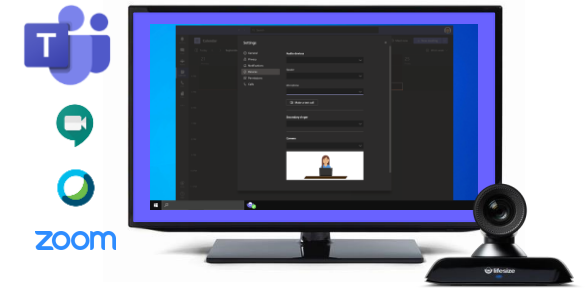
